Security squads to be formed in DU halls

A meeting of the proctors and provosts of different residential halls of Dhaka University was held Thursday with the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Mohammad Maniruzzaman Miah in the chair, a University Press release said, reports BSS.

The meeting discussed the law and order situation in the university.

campus.

The participants discussed in detail the overall law and order situation on the campus and took the following decisions.

a) The meeting sought cooperation from all concerned quarters for maintaining law and order on the campus as well as ensuring security to all.

b) No outsiders or armed person would be allowed to stay in the residential halls. The provosts of the halls if necessary, would take help of the members of the law-enforcing agencies for either ousting or arresting the outsiders and armed person from the halls.

c) The meeting decided to constitute the proposed security squad in all halls immediately. It was decided to apprise the students of their responsibility in this connection.
