DU campus remains calm

The Dhaka University Campus remained calm on Tuesday following the violent clash between the two student groups on Monday.

The clash ensued between the students of Finance and Economics Department following exchange of hot words between their teachers over a class room that left at least 10 students injured on Monday noon. The student groups called strike separately in the university on Tuesday in protest against the incident.

Most of the classes and scheduled examinations were held peacefully and the attendance of the students on the campus were usual.

The members of the warring groups were not found to hold any rally or bring out any procession in support of their strike as the university authorities prohibited processions and rallies in and around Arts and Commerce faculty areas for three days from Tuesday.
