HC issues Rule Nisi Appointment of primary teachers in Rangamati stayed

The High Court Division on Monday issued a Rule Nisi upon government to show cause within 6 weeks as to why the activities of Rangamati Local Government regarding the appointment of Primary Teachers in Rangamati shall not be declared illegal and without lawful authority.

A Division Bench of the High Court Division comprising Justice K.M. Hasan and Justice Md Abdul Quddus issued the Rule Nisi in a writ petition upon Secretary Ministry of Education, Chairman, Local Government Parisad, Rangamati and District Primary Education Officer, Rangamati and stayed all the activities regarding appointment of primary teachers of Rangamati District for three months. The writ petition was filed by Sima Chakma and Dr Mrinal Kanti Chakma.

Advocate Nizamul Haq Nasim on behalf of the petitioners submits that the present appointing committee is not formed according to the rules. He was assisted by Advocate Karunamoy Chakma and Advocate Tapon Kumar Das.
