

BCL submits memorandum to President

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) led "Chhatra Sangram Parishad" submitted a memorandum to the President and Chief Adviser of caretaker Government Prof. Iajuddin Ahmed to realize their ten-point demand on Wednesday.
