

15 rooms of hostel ransacked

14 students injured in clashes at Comilla

COMILLA, June 24:—Nine students were injured and 15 rooms were ransacked in the hostel of Comilla Polytechnic Institute at Kotbari at the night following June 15 when a group of students raided the hostel after the students union election held the previous day.

Four students, injured seriously, were admitted into Comilla General Hospital. The newly elected General Secretary of the Students Union was also injured during the raid.

The high officials and Magistrate visited the place of occurrence.

Victoria Govt. College:

Five students were injured in a clash between two rival groups of students in the installation ceremony of the newly-elected students union of Comilla Victoria Govt. College held on May 16.

Five injured students were admitted into Comilla General Hospital including the newly elected V.P. of the students union Mr. Fakruddin Mohd. Kefayetullah. It may be added here that in the last students union election Chatra League bagged 13 seats including General

Secretary and Chhatra Shibir 5 seats including V.P.

Comilla Govt. College

The Principal of Comilla Govt. College was manhandled by a group of students. The residence of Professor Mojibur Rahman Bhuiya, who was a member of the students Union Election Committee, was ransacked on May 5 immediately after the results were declared.

A meeting of the Teachers Council condemned the attacks and demanded action against the offenders. The meeting appealed to Bangladesh College Teachers Association and Teachers Association Federation to take appropriate steps.
