

DU Degree exams begin tomorrow

The Degree (Pass and Subsidiary) Examination of 1981 of the University of Dacca commences from August 27, 1981. In all, 25,500 candidates have been enrolled for this examination, recording an increase of more than 3,000 compared to last year. Of this, 14,950 candidates shall appear at the B.A. Examination, 6,025 at the B.Sc. Examination and 4,525 at the B.Com. Examination. There are in all 37 Degree Examination Centres this year as in the previous year, says a DU Press release.

9,680 candidates shall appear from the 7 examination centres located in Dacca city. An Inspection Team has been formed for Dacca City Centres with a view to observing the proceedings of the Examination and to report as to whether the examination is being conducted according to the rules and regulations of the University. In addition, special Invigilators have been appointed by the University for full time duty at Jagannath College and Shaheed Suhrawardy College Examination centres.

For the maintenance of law and order, Magistrates have been deputed for the Degree Examination Centres in city by the Deputy Commissioner of Dacca, who is the Supervising Officer of the Degree Examination Centres in Dacca.

In order to maintain uniformity in the standard of conduct of the Degree Examination, it has been decided that there shall be no examination centre under the jurisdiction of this University below the level of Sub-divisional head-quarters from 1982.
