

## Absorption of private college teachers in govt service opposed

Bangladesh Civil Service (BCS) General Education Association on Monday held a Press conference to urge the government not to renew and implement the rule enacted in 1985 to absorb under-qualified teachers of private colleges, particularly in rural areas, in government service.

Addressing the Press conference at National Press Club Mohammad Kafiluddin, Secretary General of the Association said if that rule is implemented about 10 thousand out of 12 thousand teachers working in government colleges will be hit hard.

He said under-qualified teachers working in private colleges in rural areas will be brought on top of the qualified teachers of government colleges following nationalisation of those colleges in rural areas. He said if their demand is not fulfilled, the Association will hold a grand rally in the Dhaka College compound on September 25.

Meanwhile, the Association also submitted a memorandum on their demand to the Prime Minister. They also appealed to the President not to revalidate that rule of 1985.

Mohammad Kafiluddin stated that the Association will announce its future course of action from their grand rally of September 25.
