Rajbari pry school in grip of problems

RAJBARI: Feb 23: — The Rajbari Government town muktab primary school is suffering for want of accommodation, necessary furniture and requisite teaching staff.

The school has about 600 students in its roll with an average of 125 students in each class. Classes are held in two shifts. Of the total students 50 percent are girls.

Every year 10 to 15 students obtain scholarship both in talentpool and general grade. Now the pressing need is the expansion of the school building and arrangement of furniture to accommodate students and thereby extend better facilities for education.
