BCL activists ransack IU V-C's office

ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY, (Kushtia), June 26.—Activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) ransacked the V-C office and locked other offices in the administrative building in Islamic University here demanding immediate resignation of Vice-Chancellor this morning, police sources said.

According to the eye-witnesses, the BCL activists brought out a procession at about 11 am today on the campus in protest against introduction of the Faculty of Islam and Comparative Religion and demanded resignation of Vice-Chancellor Prof Inam-ul-Hoque. After a while Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), Biplobi Chhatra Moitri and Somajtantrik Chhatra Front also brought out separate processions demanding resignation of Vice-Chancellor and protecting illegal admission of some students to the Varsity this year in

first year honours courses.

Some BCL activists entered the V-C office and ransacked it damaging furniture. They also drove out the officials from different offices of administrative building and locked the rooms. At that time two employees—Jebunnesa and Ainal were injured.

BCL activists then went to Kushtia and gheraoed V-C's residence for about three hours in the presence of more than one hundred police.
