Shibir launches week-long programme in CU

CHITTAGONG, Aug. 26:—The Islami Chhatra Shibir launched a week-long programme for what it called prevention of terrorism in Chittagong University from Sunday.

The Shibir activists on the first day of their programmes gheraoed the office of the University Proctor in support of their demand for arrest of those persons who were responsible for attack on resident students on August 14.

The Shibir also held a rally in front of the Proctor's office. The rally was addressed, among others, by Shibir leader Rezaul Karim, Golam Kabir and Khondokar Jakaria Ahmed.

Meanwhile, at least 10 students were injured in a clash between the supporters of Islami Chhatra Shibir and pro-AL Chhatra League at Hussain's Aleh Nur College at Patiya. The clash originated over enmity between two rival group of students. On the otherhand, the All Party Students Unity (APSU) leaders in a joint statement to the Press claimed that five of their party workers were thrown out of Chittagong University campus by the Shibir activists forcibly. The claimants include CU-CSU Vice President Mohammad Nazimuddin.
