PM's call to make mass edn a success

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia on Wednesday called upon the teachers and students to extend their all out cooperation to make the non-formal education programmes like mass education a success, reports BSS.

The Prime Minister said "we have given priority to education and want to farther the sector with the support of all."

Begum Khaleda Zia was addressing a ceremony of bus distribution among different educational institutions at the International Conference centre in Dhaka. Seven buses, one mini bus and two micro buses were distributed among seven educational

The educational institutions which have received the buses included Dhaka Medical College (one bus), Rajshahi Medical College (one bus), Dhaka University (Two micro buses for the teachers and two bus for the students), Jahangirnagar University (one mini bus for the teachers) Nawab Sirajdowla College Natore (one bus) Dhaka College (one bus) and Saadat University College Kortolia Tangail (one bus).

The heads of the educational institutions and the Vice Chancellors of Dhaka University and Jahangirnagar University along with students received the buses from the Prime Minister.
