Strike continues Students wear black badges in Bogra

BOGRA, Aug 26:—Educational institutions in the district remained closed for the third day today as students enforced a strike protesting the killings in the town in past few days, reports UNB.

At least six people, including three students, were killed in police firing during clashes in the town since Thursday in backlash to the death of a college student under the wheels of a bus.

Black flags flew atop schools and colleges and students wore black badges as mark of mourning the deaths.

Meanwhile, life in the trouble-torn business town started returning to normal with no reports of violence on Monday although protest continued.

Most business establishments opened their shutters today after four days of closure amidst an orgy of student-police encounter.

Rickshaws took to the street, but interdistrict bus services remained still suspended.
