## VCs concerned over unrest at different varsities

Vice Chancellors of 11 different universities in a statement on Sunday expressed their deep concern over the unrest created by some of the students under the banner of different organisations in some universities. They termed the agitation of these students as 'irrelevant' and said that they were trying to stop the functioning of the universities.

"It will be good for the students if they exchange their views rationally with the authorities instead of creating deadlock at universities causing session jam", said the statement signed by the 11 vice chancellors.

"Though the universities have to face lots of shortcoming, they
