Teachers of Govt colleges threaten to boycott HSC exams

Teachers of Government Colleges on Sunday threatened to go for non-stop work abstention and boycott the Higher Secondary Certificate examinations of 1995 if their 12-points demand was not met immediately.

Bangladesh Government College Lecturers' Association and Professor's Association in a joint statement criticised the Government for its delaying tactics to implement the 12-point demand and said that assurance was given several times by the government in this respect but no initiative was taken till today, says a Press release.

Teachers of Government Colleges will gherao the Directorate of Education on February 4 and submit memorandum to the Director General in support of their demands. They will observe two-hour token strike (10 a.m. to 12 noon) from March 11 to March 16 and will go for non-stop work abstention on April 8. If necessary measures were not taken by this time, teachers will boycott HSC examinations of 1995 the Press release added.
