



Govt to set up 14 model schools in city

The government has undertaken a project to set up 10 new higher secondary model schools in the city at a cost of Tk 114 crore in view of scrambles for admission into good educational institutions, reports UNB.

Work on four schools will start this fiscal year. The government from its own fund will finance the scheme," said an official announcement Tuesday.

Foundation stone of the Muhammadpur Higher Secondary Model School was laid on three acres of land in the Dhaka Residential Model School and College premises Thursday, starting off quick implementation of the scheme.

Education Minister Dr Osman Faruk was present on the occasion as chief guest and State Minister for Education ANM Ehsanul Haque Milon as special guest.
