Student shot dead in Ploytech hostel

One student of the Dhaka Polytechnic Institute was shot dead and another was injured seriously inside their room in the early morning of Saturday.

The deceased was identified as Mr.

the attackers shot the victim from the rear and he died on the spot. They also attacked Abdur Rab, the room-mate of the victim, when he came to resist the attackers. Two of his teeth and left hand were fractured in the

It was learnt that he was killed as a result of a internal conflict of the student organisation he belonged to. He was planing to contest the forth coming college election, sources said.

Receiving the information police rushed to the spot and arrested three persons in this connection. When contacted Tajgaon police admitted the taking three students into custody and said they were being interrogated.


The arrested students were identified as Shafayat Hossain Sabuj, Mamun, and Sharif Mahmud.

The attackers numbering about four knocked the door of the victim Shahabuddin and asked to open the door. Abdur Rab, resident of the room Number 105 of the Latif Hostel and the room-mate of the victim opened the door. Immediately after opening the door the attackers aimed their gun at him and commanded to keep silent. Hearing the talks between the attackers and his room-mate Shahabuddin woke up and tried to come down from his bed just at that time the attackers fired two shots at him.

The sleeping students of the hostel woke up following the gun shots but could not come to the spot out of fear.

Later the attackers hired a baby taxi bearing number Dhaka Metro- Tha-02-2157 and sent the body of the victim to the DMCH.

A case has been registered with the Tajgaon police in this connection.
