

The newly appointed Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University, Professor Dr Anwarullah Chowdhury, on Wednesday vowed to free the university campus from terrorists and outsiders as early as possible, reports BSS.

Addressing a Press conference at his office, he said the terrorists, whoever they might be, would be punished according to the University Act. He said he would try to restore the past glory and image of the University.

Prof. Chowdhury urged journalists not only to report terrorism or negative aspects but also the positive and developmental aspects of the University for information of people.

A six-member inquiry committee was formed with newly appointed Proctor Professor Dr Nazrul Islam as convenor to investigate untoward incidents in Jagannath Hall and Zahrul Haque Hall.

The committee will submit the reports within seven days and if the accused persons could be identified, the disciplinary committee will take proper action, he added.

Prof. Dr Nazrul Islam of Political Science Department was appointed Proctor relieving Professor Dr Noorunnabi of Social Science Department.

Replying to a question on curbing violence on the campus, he outlined short and long-term measures depending on the degree of violence.

Elections of the Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) and the hall unions will be held as early as possible to restore academic atmosphere, he added.
