

Books inimical to culture may not be imported

DHAKA, BSS: Minister for Education and Cultural Affairs Prof. A.Q.M. Badruddoza Chowdhury on Friday said the government would consider to take measures to stop import of different books including books of primary education which creates obstacles to flourishing of our literature and culture.

He said our language, literature and culture are our pride and those who nourishes our literature and culture are our good friends.

Prof. Chowdhury said the spirits of the Liberation War and Language Movement have created a new chapter in our cultural heritage and enriched our literature.

He said "as a nation we may feel proud for our literature and culture". He also called upon the litterateurs and intellectuals to uphold the image of the country abroad through better projection of our literature and culture.
