

Attack by BCL rivals feared JCD activists not appearing at exam

Activists of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) reportedly did not appear at their examinations held at Dhaka University Science Annex Building Saturday apprehending attack by Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) activists.

Masters degree and Honours final examinations had started from Thursday but the examinees refrained from entering the Annex Building examination hall.

BCL activists gheraoed Annex Building area at about 9.30 a.m. by the day.

Eye witnesses said, the BCL activists were trying to establish their influence in and around Curzon Hall and Annex Building areas.

According to another report, Dhaka University campus situation deteriorated once again Saturday night following an internal clash between activists of two founding groups of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at Surya Sen Hall, where two JCD workers were injured. One of them received bullet injury.

JCD activist Shahjada received bullet injury in his leg while another—Tarikul Islam Bonny—was beaten up with a rifle butt inside Surya Sen Hall at about 11.30 p.m.

Sounds of sporadic gun shots from different student dormitories were heard during the clash.

Shahjada was taken to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital from where he was shifted to Pangu Hospital while Bonny was admitted to a city clinic.

The condition of Shahjada was said to be critical.
