The second chapter of canal digging under the first phase of peaceful revolution began on Saturday with the inauguration of the Chirir river excavation project. It is expected that a total of 700 canals and rivers will be excavated and re-excavated during the current year. When completed about 15 to 20 lakh acres of land will come under winter irrigation in the project areas. On December 1 last year President Ziaur Rahman inaugurated the canal digging programme as the first phase of his peaceful revolution.
