Canal digging in Bogra going apace

BOGRA, Jan 13: The work of canal re-excavation projects in the district is progressing satisfactorily. Hundreds of enthusiastic men and women from all walks of life including students have been participating in the canal re-excavation work in this district.

The 5-mile long Sukhdar Canal re-excavation project was formally inaugurated by the Railway and Road Transport Minister Mr. Abdul Alim recently. The project when completed will provide irrigation facilities to 2,500 acres of land where cultivation of different additional crops of Tk. 67 lakh will be possible and many families will be benefitted.

In all 18 power pumps will be installed for irrigation purpose soon.

The re-excavation work of 2-miles long Rangta-Murarpur Canal in Jaypurhat subdivision was formally inaugurated recently by the Deputy Commissioner.

According to the report 50 per cent work of the project have been completed so far. The canal will provide irrigation facilities for additional production of different crops to 1,000 acres of land.
