Make mass literacy programme a success: SHC

MYMENSINGH, Sept. 5 : Information and Broadcasting Minister Mr. Shamsul Huda Chowdhury today called upon the educated persons to come forward for eradication of illiteracy from the society, reports BSS.

The Minister was addressing the teachers and students of Sankiara Night School in the town this evening.

Mr. Chowdhury said that the government believed in the politics of economic well-being which, he observed, could not be achieved through processions and slogans. In this context, the Minister said that rate of illiteracy in Bangladesh was very high compared to other countries which was one of the bottleneck to our economic development.
