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SSC exam begins Thursday

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination, 1989, begins under all the four education boards on Thursday.

A total of 4,48,824 candidates including 1,36,761 girls will appear in the examination from 477 centres in the country and seven centres abroad this year. Of the seven overseas centres, six are located in the Middle-Eastern countries and one in London.

According to Controllers Offices of four education boards preparation for the examination was completed and all the Deputy Commissioners have been requested to take necessary measures for peaceful holding of the examination.

According to decision, restriction on assembly of more than

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four persons would remain imposed under Section 144 around the examination centres to avoid any untoward incident during the examination.

Special invigilator's team will also visit different centres during the examination to ensure fair examination.

The authorities have already sought cooperation from the guardians and members of the public for peaceful holding of the examination.
