HSC exams from June 13

A total of 2,42,899 examinees are appearing the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations from 524 centres under four education boards this year. The examinations will begin from June 13.

According to official source, preparation for the examination is almost complete. The Ministry of Education has requested all concerns including local administration and law enforcing agencies to extend their cooperation for holding the examination peacefully.

Of the total candidates 75,271 are appearing from Dhaka Board, 60,778 from

Rajshahi Board 58,072 from Jessore Board and 48,778 from Comilla Board.

According to the Controller of Dhaka Board, 55,462 male and 19,869 female candidates will appear from 150 centres including eight overseas centres under the board.

The overseas centres will be set up in Riyadh, Jeddah, Kuwait, Manama, Karachi, London and Washington.

A total of 2,312 candidates will be shifted to nearby centres due to cancellation of six centres under Dhaka Board, he said.

He also said that Diploma in Commerce Examination under the board will begin simultaneously on June 13 in 16 centres throughout the country. A total of 1,949 candidates will appear the examination.
