## Unfair means in Rajshahi Board HSC exam to be sternly resisted

RAJSHAHI, Aug 19: Chairman of Rajshahi Secondary and Higher Secondary Board, Prof Hazi Abdul Salam, told a press conference today that any sort of unfair means in the examination halls would be resisted sternly in the HSC examination scheduled on next Thursday, reports BSS.

He said 21 vigilant teams with 100 members of BCS (Education) cadre have already been constituted to supervise the examination.

He said steps were being taken to ensure law and order situation for holding the examination in a fair and peaceful manner.

cluding 53,707 male students and 17,047 female students will appear in the examination. The examination will be held in 154 centres under the board.
