## 1,280 more expelled from HSC exams

A total of about 1,280 candidates were expelled on the fourth day of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination on Tuesday, according to reports received from four education boards—Dhaka, Rajshahi, Comilla and Jessore.

With these the total number of candidates expelled on the first day (two Bengali papers), on Sunday (two English papers) and Tuesday (physics, economics and business methods first paper) rose to about 5,629 under the four education boards of the country.

According to the Dhaka Board authority, a total of about 343 examinees were expelled from 47

centres of the board for adopting unfairmeans during Tuesday's examinations.

Of them 100 were expelled from 7 centres of Faridpur, 40 from 5 centres of Sherpur, one from a centre of Rajbari, 71 from 11 centres of Tangail, 30 from 7 centres of Narshingdi, 28 from 4 centres of Narayanganj, 48 from 7 centres of Jamalpur and 25 from 5 centres of Munshigonj.

According to Rajshahi Board officials, a total of about 338 candidates were expelled from 47 centres of the nine districts of the board for adoption of unfairmeans on Tuesday. Of them 14 were

expelled from 4 centres of Nawabgonj, 46 from 5 centres of Nilphamari, 8 from 3 centres of Joypurhat, one from a centre of Lalmonirhat, 14 from 4 centres of Gaibandha, 35 from 4 centres of Thakurgaon, 112 from 12 centres of Dinajpur, 37 from 8 centres of Sirajgonj and 28 from 7 centres of Rajshahi.

According to Comilla board officials, a total of about 556 candidates were expelled from 26 centres of the board for adoption of unfairmeans on Tuesday. Of them 417 examinees were expelled from 12 centres under the Comilla district.

According to Jessore Board officials, a total of about 43 candidates were expelled on Tuesday from 14 centers of the board. Of them 17 examinees were expelled from Jessore, two from Jhenidah, 8 from Narail, 15 from Khulna and one from Magura district.
