candidates expelled

A total of 1,107 candidates were expelled from different centres under three education boards on the first day of HSC Examination Thursday, reports UNB.

Rajshahi Board topped the expulsion list with 979 while 64 examinees each were expelled from the Dhaka and Jessore boards.

In Rajshahi Board, the highest number expelled in Dinajpur was 347, followed by Rangpur with 143 expulsions.

Other expulsions under the board were as follows: Nawabganj-14, Natore-13, Naogaon-20, Pabna-10, Joypurhat-13, Panchagar-23, Thakurgaon-73.

A total of 1,107 candidates were expelled from different centres under Dhaka Board, the highest number being 15 from Jamalpur followed by 13 from Madaripur, Board sources said.

Others expelled were from Manikganj-7, Narsingdhi-11, Rajbari-3, Shariatpur-9 and Tangail-6.

Under Jessore Board, some 64 candidates were expelled from different centres, the highest number expelled from Kushtia was 23, followed by Khulna-11.

Others expelled were: Narail-3, Jhenidah-1, Meherpur-3, Barisal-5, Pirojpur-3, Bhola-1, Satkhira-1, Jhalakathi-6, Patuakhali-4, Bagerhat-1 and Jessore-2.

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examination of Comilla Board could not be held simultaneously with the three boards, as its postponed SSC Examination began Thursday.
