Objective system of SSC exam to stay: Press Note

The Government on Sunday categorically said that the objective system of SSC Examination would be retained, reports BSS.

A Press Note issued by the Education Ministry said for maintaining the standard of examination and making the objective system more effective and fruitful, objective questions will be set from the approved syllabus. The SSC examinees will have to secure a minimum of 12 (twelve) marks in each part of the subjects having objective, essay and practical. They will have to secure a minimum 15 marks in each part in the papers having 50 marks for essay type and 50 marks objective type, the Press

In the light of the reports appearing in different newspapers in the country on the student demonstrations demanding retention of objective system in the SSC examination, the government firmly said the system of objective type questions was introduced in the SSC examination of 1992 after extensive review of the system at the intellectual and expert levels.
