Government on Tuesday formed powerful vigilance teams at the district and upazila levels and announced tough measures to combat copying and malpractices in the forthcoming HSC examinations of Dhaka, Rajshahi, Jessore and Comilla boards scheduled to begin June 25, reports BSS.

The measures were taken to ensure the scheduled HSC examinations in a corruption-free, fair and peaceful atmosphere, a PID handout said on Tuesday.

Directives were given to maintain law and order properly at the examination centres. The presence of all types of outsiders would be completely banned and 144 would be imposed in the examination centres, the handout added.
