

SSC exams begin today

6.79 lakhs appear from four boards

Secondary School Certificate Examinations for the year 1993 begin today (Monday) simultaneously in four education

boards. 616 examination centres under Dhaka, Comilla, Rajshahi and Jessore education boards, according to official sources.

The number of examinees in Dhaka Board is 219,582, in Comilla Board 167,416, in Rajshahi Board 154,318 and in Jessore Board 1,37,694. Five SSC examination centres set up abroad are at Jeddah, Riyadh, Abudhabi, Doha and Tripoli. A total of 88 candidates will appear at in these centres

Meanwhile, authorities concerned have taken adequate measures for the peaceful holding of the examinations. Members of law enforcing agencies will be deployed in and around all examination centres.

An official handout issued on Sunday said the government has already made all necessary arrangements for holding the SSC examinations in a peaceful

and corruption-free manner. All measures have already been taken to maintain law and order in and around examination centres, the handout added.

Detailed instructions have been made available to Chairman of the Education Boards Deputy Commissioners and Secretaries of the examination centres to ensure peaceful and fair examinations.

Vigilance teams have been constituted by the Education Ministry, boards and concerned deputy commissioners to make examinations free from unfair means.

The candidates will be searched to remove any copying materials and anybody found with any books for copying materials in the examinations halls will be expelled.

The teachers of concerned schools will not be made superintendents or invigilators of the centres where their students are sitting for examinations.
