

Excessive fees being realised for SSC exam under JB

MAGURA, Jan 16: Excessive fees for the Secondary School Certificates Examinations under the Jessore Board are being realised from the examinees. By violating the Board Order the different high school authorities are realising excessive fees from students. As a result, thousands of examinees will not be able to sit for the examination, it is apprehended.

The Jessore Board has fixed the fee for per theoretical paper at Taka 25, practical paper at Taka 40, centre fee Taka 40 and marksheet fee Taka 25. An examinee is required a total of Taka 315 for appearing in the examination. But some high schools authorities are realising Taka 1500 to 2000 from every students against Board fixed rate.

The guardians of SSC examinees are compelled to sell either their moveable or immoveable properties to pay excess fees.

TEXT BOOKS DISTRIBUTED

Magura District Primary Education office will distribute a total of 1,34,300 set text books among the students of 267 government primary schools, 83 registered and 14 non registered non-government primary schools in four thanas of Magura district during the current accademic season with free of cost under compulsory primary education programme.

According to an official source out of the total text books 54,900 set will be distributed in Magura sadar thana, 31,150 set in Mohammadpur thana.
