

DU students for recovery of illegal arms from campus

Different student organisations Saturday brought out separate processions and held rallies at Dhaka University campus demanding the immediate recovery of illegal arms and arrest of terrorists from the university, according to press release, reports BSS.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) leaders at the rally alleged that armed outsiders were still sheltered at Mohsin, Surjaseen, Zia, Bangabandhu and Jashimuddin halls of the university.
