Directives to printers of newspapers, periodicals

The Government has asked the printers of the newspapers and periodicals of the country to deliver copies of all issues of newspapers and periodicals, as soon as those are published, to certain specified Government officials as a proof of their regular publication, reports BSS.

This is a statutory requirement and there is also a provision for penalty under the law against defaulters in this respect, an official handout said in Dhaka on Thursday.

According to a Government notification issued recently under, Section 26 of the Printing and Publications Declaration and Registration Act, 1973, the printer of every newspaper and periodical is required to deliver its copies, as soon as it is published, to the officers in the manner noted below:

Three copies of each issue of such newspaper to the De-

puty Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, Political Branch, Bangladesh Secretariat Dhaka at his office, and one copy of each issue of such newspaper to the officers mentioned below at their respective offices:

In the case of a newspaper printed in Dhaka-Director, Department of Films and Publications, 112 Circuit House Road Dhaka, Deputy Commissioner, Dhaka and Deputy Inspector-General of Police, Special Branch, Dhaka and in the case of a newspaper printed outside Dhaka-Director, Department of Films & Publications, 112 Circuit House Road, Dhaka-Deputy Commissioner of the district within the local limits of which the newspaper is printed, and Superintendent of Police Special Branch of the district within the local limits of which the Newspaper is printed.
