

Time-scale for primary teachers under study

The Government has been actively considering introduction of time-scale for the country's primary school teachers, Education Minister Shamsul Huda Chowdhury said in Dhaka on Friday reports BSS.

Speaking as chief guest at the fourth Motijheel Thana Inter Primary School Sports prize giving ceremony on Friday, the Minister also said that primary schools in 60 upazilas of the country would

be brought under an overall development scheme with the help of the World Bank.

He said last year primary schools in 44 upazilas had been developed under World Bank scheme. The Minister also assured that primary schools in Dhaka city would be brought under development scheme on a priority basis.

He described the primary teachers as the 'educated leaders' in the rural society who could play important role in country's socio-economic uplift.

Mr. Chowdhury recounted different measures taken by the government in developing the primary education sector giving it the top-most priority since 'it is the foundation of the nation of the national education system.'
