

Justice Islam appointed Law Minister Justice Masud made CEC

The President and Chief Martial Law Administrator, Lt. Gen. H. M. Ershad on Sunday appointed Justice A K M. Nurul Islam, the Chief Election Commissioner, as a Minister, reports BSS.

Earlier, Justice Islam resigned from the office of the Chief Election Commissioner.

The President also appointed

Mr Justice Chowdhury A. T. M. Masud, a Judge of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court, as the new Chief Election Commissioner of Bangladesh.

President Ershad administered the oath of offices to the newly-appointed Minister and the Chief Election Commissioner at a simple ceremony held at Banghaban in Dhaka on Sunday

night.

The function was attended, among others by the DCMLAs—Rear Admiral Sultan Ahmad and Air Vice-Marshal Sultan Mahmud, Ministers, Advisers to the President and high civil and military officers.

Justice Nurul Islam has been assigned the Ministry of Law and Justice.
