



Fakhruzzaman dead

Dr. Mir Fakhruzzaman, Professor of Psychology at Dhaka University, died at P. G. Hospital on Thursday morning. He was 56.

A former Vice-Chancellor of Islamic University at Santosh and a former Head of the Department of Psychology at Dhaka University, Dr. Fakhruzzaman was critically injured on Wednesday when his taxi collided with a microbus at Bhatkura bridge on Dhaka-Tangail road. He was going to Santosh along with two of his associates. He was immediately rushed to P. G. Hospital where he succumbed to his head injury at 4.30 a. m.

His Namaje-Janaja was held at Dhaka University Central Mosque after Asar prayer and he was laid to rest at Islamic University campus in Santosh on Thursday.

Following the news of his death a large number of adm-

rers, former colleagues, students and relatives visited P.G. Hospital to pay homage to the late teacher. Vice-President Justice A.K.M. Nurul Islam, Energy Minister Mr. Anwar Hossain and Communication Minister Mr. Matiur Rahman also visited P.G. Hospital in the morning to pay tribute to the late professor.

Prof. Fakhruzzaman joined the Department of Psychology, Dhaka University in July 1955. He was the Head of the Department for long ten years and served as House Tutor of Dhaka Hall (now Shahidullah Hall) and Provost of Fazlul Huq Hall.

His Oul Khwani will be held after Asar prayer on February 2 at his Dhaka University quarter (34/A). A condolence meeting will be held at T.S.C. at 12.15 p.m. tomorrow (Saturday). Classes will remain suspended between 11.50 a.m. and 1.20 p.m. on this occasion.

Dr. Fakhruzzaman left behind his wife, seven sons and one daughter to mourn his death.
