



Lutful Haider Chowdhury dead

Prof Lutful Haider Chowdhury, Chairman of the National Curriculum and Text Book Board died of heart failure at Amanat Shah Road residence at 11-45 pm on Friday. He was 55.

He left behind his wife and two sons. He was buried at the Banani graveyard after the Namaj-e-Janaza at the Baitul Mukarram.

His elder brother Prof Mozazzal Haider Chowdhury was killed during the War of Liberation in 1971. Prof Lutful Haider Chowdhury began his career as a journalist in the Daily Sangbad.

He was appointed Chairman of the Text Book Board on October 13, 1988. Qul Khwani for the deceased will be held at his residence after Asar prayer on November 15.
