## Govt committed to present an educated nation

KISHOREGANJ, June 24 (BSS): Law and Justice Minister Habibul Islam Bhuiyan Saturday said the government was committed to present an educated nation.

This way, he said, and educated nation would bring about tremendous progress and prosperity of the country.

He was addressing a gathering of teachers, students and guardians at Zila Sharani Girls High School here Saturday.
