Talks with BCS Education Assoc fruitful

The leaders of BCS General Education Association had a fruitful discussion with Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar on the 16-point demand of the Association during a meeting held at the Conference Room of the Ministry of Education in Dhaka Monday, according to an official handout, reports
