

DU campus calm, but tension prevails

Dhaka University campus was calm although tension was prevailing on the campus following exchange of gun shots between the activists of two rival student organisations Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and pro-Awami Chhatra League on Thursday night.

Sporadic gun shots were heard from 7.30 p.m. to 1 a.m. in different students dormitories Mohsin Hall, Jahurul Haq Hall, S.M. Hall, Jagannath Hall and Surjaseen Hall areas. More than five hundred

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rounds of gun shots were heard although no injury was reported.

DUCSU

Dhaka University Central Students Union office was ransacked by some unruly activists of a rival student organisation at about 9.30 p.m. the same night.

DUCSU Vice-President

Amanullah Aman MP and general Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokon in a statement Friday condemned the ransacking incident of DUCSU building.

They demanded arrest and trial of the persons responsible for the ransacking of DUCSU office. They also reiterated arrest and trial of the suspected killers of Dr Milon.

JCD

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) Central Committee at a meeting Friday condemned the ransacking of the DUCSU office. The meeting was presided over by JCD Joint Convener Fazlul Haq Milon.

JCD leaders blamed pro-Awami Chhatra League for the ransacking of DUCSU office.

Earlier, JCD brought out a protest procession and held a rally demanding arrest and trial of the armed hoodlums responsible for the campus violence.
