DU classes resume Dec 7

Classes of Dhaka University will resume on December 7 as teachers of the university have decided to call off abstention programme.

Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) at an emergency meeting Monday took this decision with the DUTA President Anwarullah Chowdhury in the chair.

The meeting hoped that the government and the university authorities would take necessary measures against the violent activities by December 6. The government and concerned authorities would be responsible if the effective measures would not be taken and violent activities would continue.

The DUTA went on abstention from duties on November 2 following a bloody gun battle between two rival student organisations Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) student front of Awami League and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) student wing of Bangladesh Nationalist Party on the campus on November 27, which causes death to four persons including two students of the university.

The DUTA expressed resentment over the government role for not taking effective measures for eradicating campus violence.

The teachers hoped that the government should take effective steps for eliminating campus terrorism with in December 6.
