**Students go on
rampage, damage
cars, blast bombs:
59 arrested**

A section of SSC students of some city schools Saturday staged demonstration in front of the National Press Club protesting "withdrawal of 500-objective question bank" from the next SSC examinations. Students went on a rampage on Topkhana Road and damaged at least three vehicles. Chased by the police, they blasted three hand bombs.

Vehicular traffic through Topkhana Road remained suspended for more than three hours beginning from 1 p.m. because of the trouble.
