GCO rally held

Gunshots rock DU campus

Gun shots rocked Dhaka University campus once again on Saturday.

However, none was reportedly injured and the cause of the firing was not ascertained immediately.

Unidentified miscreants hurled cocktails at the nearby road of Mohsin Hall and following the blast several rounds of gunshots were fired from the

directions of Jahurul Huq Hall and Mohsin Hall. Police on duty at DU campus cordoned the area immediately after the incident. Meanwhile, leaders and activists of Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya Saturday submitted a memorandum to Prof. Enajuddin Ahmed, Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University demanding a violence-free campus.

Earlier, the GCO organised a rally in front of the Vice-Chancellor's office.

The rally was addressed among others by Ruhul Kuddus Babu, Abdullah Hili Quayyum, Ruhin Hossain Prince and Ragib Ahsan Munna. Speakers at the rally urged the University authorities for immediate expulsion of the persons responsible for violent incident at DU administrative building in which a central leader of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) was killed and three employees of DU were injured on Monday last.

The leaders called upon the law enforcing agency authority to recover arms and ammunition in different students dormitories of the University.

The leaders also demanded for publishing of all probe body reports of DU killing till today.

Earlier, the GCO leaders and activists brought out a procession on the campus.
