

Arms, ammunition seized Police raid Suhrawardy College, 7 arrested

Police rounded up seven alleged terrorists and recovered some small arms and ammunition in a raid inside the Suhrawardy College near Victoria Park of the old city Tuesday morning.

The raid followed a brief exchange of gunfires between two rival groups of students at about 6:00 A.M on Tuesday.

The arrested are: Moshiur, Mahmudul, Shamsul Alam, Salchin, Mahbub, Alam and Akhram. All they are second year students of the college, it is learnt.

According to Sutrapur Police, two rival groups of students exchanged at least 15 rounds of gun shots at about 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday for establishing their supremacy in the area.

Police raided the college and its students dormitories following the incident and arrested seven persons from a class room of the college and recovered a foreign made pistol and a local made pistol with 68 rounds of .22 bore rifle and 16 rounds of 303 rifle from their possession.

They were making preparations for another gun fight, police said.

Three cases were registered

with Sutrapur Police Station under Anti-Terrorism Act and Arms Act in this connection.

Meanwhile Dhanmondi police on Tuesday interrogated Anamullah Alias Aman, an accused for creating violence recently at the office of Dainik Ajker Kagoj and upon his confessional statement, police recovered a cut-rifle on Tuesday early morning from an under-construction building located at 53, Moneswar Road under Lalbagh police station.

Police further said that the accused on previous occasions was arrested with arms and later was released on bail.

A case under the Arms Act is recorded against the accused with Dhanmondi Police Station.

Meanwhile Tejgaon police on Tuesday afternoon arrested one Mohammad Abul from in front of Planning Commission when he tried to flee after stealing a motor-cycle (Yamaha 100cc Dhaka Ha-4435) from the corridor of Suhrawardy Hospital in city.

Police chased the accused and caught him red-handed.

A case is recorded with Tejgaon Police Station in this connection.

Meanwhile the detective Branch and the DMP arrested 103 persons from different parts of the city on charge of various crimes during the last 24 hours ending at 6 p.m. on Tuesday.
