BL College closed since die after students clash

KHULNA, July 28 : Authorities of Government BL College at Daulatpur here today closed down the college for an indefinite period following a clash between activists of Shibir and BCL, JCD and others in the campus, reports UNB.

The college authorities have also asked the students to vacate the halls by 10 pm tonight.

The clash, following the judgement of Shafiq murder case Monday, erupted between the supporters of the rival groups.

Shafiq, a Shibir leader of Rajshahi University was killed by during a violence in 1989, April 18 on the campus. the judgement of the killing was awarded Monday which acquitted all the accused, 18 of whom were activists of Gonotantric Chhatra Otykka.

Tension in the campus, which has been prevailing since the judgement was pronounced, mounted at around 10 am today when supporters of BCL, JCD and Chhatra Maitri entered the campus forcibly.

Shibir activists were resisting other students from enter-

ing the campus since the announcement of the judgement.

The clash with chase and counter chase lasted till 6 pm resulting in injury of four activists. Several rooms in four halls were also ransacked during the clash.

The injured are Nazrul Islam and Ahad of Shibir, Sirajul Islam (BCL) and Biplob of (JCD).

Meanwhile, eight platoons of riot police were deployed in the campus and hall areas.
