Over 250 BCL members join JCD

Students asked to exercise tolerance

More than a hundred leaders and workers of Bangladesh Chhatra League of Narail district on Monday joined Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal expressing their total support to the policies and ideals of BNP, reports BSS.
