Consensus to hold DUCSU polls soon

Dhaka University Paribesh Parishad reached a consensus to hold Dhaka University Central Students' Union (DUCSU) election as early as possible.

The meeting of Paribesh Parishad was held on Thursday at Senate Room of Administrative Building. Vice Chancellor Prof A K Azad Chowdhury chaired the meeting.

Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) boycott the meeting, protesting the presence of DU Proctor, Dr Nurun Nabi in the meeting.

The meeting reviewed the overall situation of the university and expressed satisfaction that the law and order situation of the university is better than in the past.

VC Prof A.K. Azad Chowdhury urged all student organi-

Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) demanded immediate dissolution of DUCSU and declare schedule for holding new DUCSU election. Enamul Haq Shameem, President of BCL Central Committee, Ishak Ali Khan Panna, General Secretary of the organisation, Bahadur Bapari President BCL DU unit, and Abdul Wadud Khokon General Secretary of BCL DU unit, attended the meeting.

The leaders of Gonotantrik Chhatra Oikya also demanded dissolution of DUCSU immediately.

The leaders present at the meeting were Aslam Khan President of Chhatra Union, Obaidul Haq Chunnu President BCL (C-K), Ziaul Haq Zia of Chhatra Moitree and Mahabubul Haq Ripon of Chhatra Union.
