

HSC exam results of four boards announced

Results of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations of the country's four education boards held in August/September this year were simultaneously announced on Tuesday.

A total of 3,98,540 candidates appeared in the examinations under the four education boards and 1,61,045 came out successful. The average percentage of pass is 39.88.

In Dhaka Board, a total of 59,135 students passed out of 1,38,312 appeared in the examinations. The percentage of pass is 42.75. Out of the total candidates appeared, 90,376

were male while the number of female students were 47,936. The percentage of successful male and female students are 41.51 and 45.10 respectively.

A total of 16,193 examinees have been passed in the First Division, 34,737 in the Second Division and 8,205 in the Third Division.

In Comilla Board, a total 37,496 students have passed out of 89,335 examinees appeared in the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination, 1994.

The percentage of pass in Comilla Board is 41.97. Out of the total students appeared in the examinations, 59,478 are

male and 29,857 female. The percentage of pass of male and female examinees are 42.09 and 41.74 respectively.

Of the total students who have come out successful, 3,892 have passed in the First Division, 23,962 in the Second Division and 9,642 in the Third Division.

In Rajshahi Board, a total 38,108 students have come out successful out of 94,945 candidates appeared in the examinations.

The percentage of pass is 40.13. Of the total examinees appeared in the examinations, 66,345 were male and 28,611 female. The percentage of successful male and female students have been recorded as 39.64 and 41.25 respectively.

A total of 4,876 examinees have been placed in the First Division, 23,647 in the Second Division and 9,585 in the Third Division.

In Jessore Board, a total of 26,306 examinees have come out successful out of 75,928 candidates appeared in the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examinations, 1994.

The percentage of pass is 34.65 out of the examinees appeared 51,531 are male and 24,397 female. The percentage of successful male and female students are 33.81 and 36.41 respectively.

A total of 5,510 examinees have been placed in the First Division, 17,016 in the Second Division and 3,780 in the Third Division.

The following is the combined merit list (Science, Agricultural Science and Home Economics group) of Dhaka Education Board Farah Farzana, roll no. 110767 of Vigarunnissa Noon College of Dhaka topped the combined merit list securing 969 marks. She got letters in four subjects - Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Statistics.

Shamsi Tamara Iqbal, roll no. 110769 and Sayema Haque Bidisha, roll no. 110768 of Vigarunnissa Noon College of Dhaka stood second and third with 957 and 946 marks respectively. Shamsi Tamara Iqbal got letters in five subjects and Bidisha in four.

Mehbub-ur-Rahman, roll no. 103408 of Dhaka College stood fourth securing 943 marks with four letters, Abdulla-Al-Amin bearing roll no. 10386 of Dhaka College and Raihana Musawir, roll no. 110940 of Vigarunnissa Noon College combinedly secured fifth position with same aggregate 942. Abdullah got four letters and Raihana Musawir also got four letters. Manzur Ashraf bearing roll no. 103387 of Dhaka College stood sixth securing 941 marks with four

letters.
