

Question bank in SSC Over 3 dozen buses damaged in city, Ctg

A number of SSC candidates on Sunday ransacked about 25 vehicles at the Mirpur area in protest against the decision of annulment of question bank in SSC examination from next year.

Being agitated by the decision, students went on rampage at Mirpur section 1, 10 and in front of the Mirpur Government College at 12.30 pm. They ransacked different modes of 25 vehicles. At about 2 pm police brought the situation under control. Police also picked up one youth named Monir Hossain (16) from Mirpur-1 during the melee.

A case has been filed with Mirpur thana in this regard.

CHITTAGONG

UNB from Chittagong says: Traffic on the Dhaka-Chittagong highway was disrupted for about five hours as the school students blocked the road demanding reintroduction of the old method of the SSC examination.

The angry students put up barricades at Mirersarai, Nizampur, Hadisakirhat and Darogarhat at about 12 noon. They damaged more than a dozen vehicles, including three BRTC buses.
