**Notice For Admission into C-in-Ed Course in
the Primary Training Institutes**

Applications from external candidates are invited for admission into the one year-long C-in-Ed Course of 1984-85 Session in the Govt. Primary Training Institutes. Intending candidates have to take part in admission test in the training institute of own area or any particular institute to their convenience and they will be admitted on the basis of the results of said test. From the current session Kushtia and Jaipurhat P.T. It will also be opened. Number of seats for external male and female candidates will be 50:50. In case of selection of external candidates, 20% (twenty per cent) seats will be kept reserved for eligible candidates dependent on teachers working in government primary schools or retired teachers of the same. If required number of candidates dependent on teachers is not available then the vacant seats reserved for them will be filled up with external candidates.

Major portion of selected trainees will get stipend of Tk. 150/- (one hundred fifty) per month on the basis of merit. The distribution percentage of stipend between male and female candidates will be 50:50. After successful completion of the course every stipend holder should sign a contract to the effect that they would teach in primary school for at least 5 years for government's necessity. External candidates have to take their training in the institute in which they would take part in the admission test. Nobody will be transferred to any other institute under any circumstances. A candidate will not be allowed to appear at the examination if he fails to present at 80% classes of that session, and his admission will be treated as cancelled if he remains absent for 15 days consecutively.

For application the following conditions should be fulfilled.

1. Minimum Educational Qualification:

Male Candidates HSC/Fazil. But should have Second Division in SSC/Alim or HSC/Fazil. Bengali and English are must in Alim and Fazil examinations.

Female Candidates - SSC Second Division.

2. Age (at 31.12.84): 17 to 25 years. Relaxable upto 30 years in case of working teachers.

3. Nationality:- Citizen of Bangladesh.

Intending candidates should submit application in plain paper mentioning name, father's name, date of birth, permanent address, present address, educational qualification with divisions together with two passport-sized photographs and a Fee of Tk. 5/- by 4 p.m. of 1st December, 1984 to the Superintendent concerned. The written test will take place at the Primary Training Institutes on 9th December 1984 at 9 a.m. (Sunday). The date and time of viva will be announced by the Superintendents.

N.B. If the reserved seats for working teacher in government primary schools remain vacant, the external candidates who would obtain qualifying marks and willing to take the training without stipend, can be admitted on merit basis and male/female ratio subject to signing of a bond to this effect.
